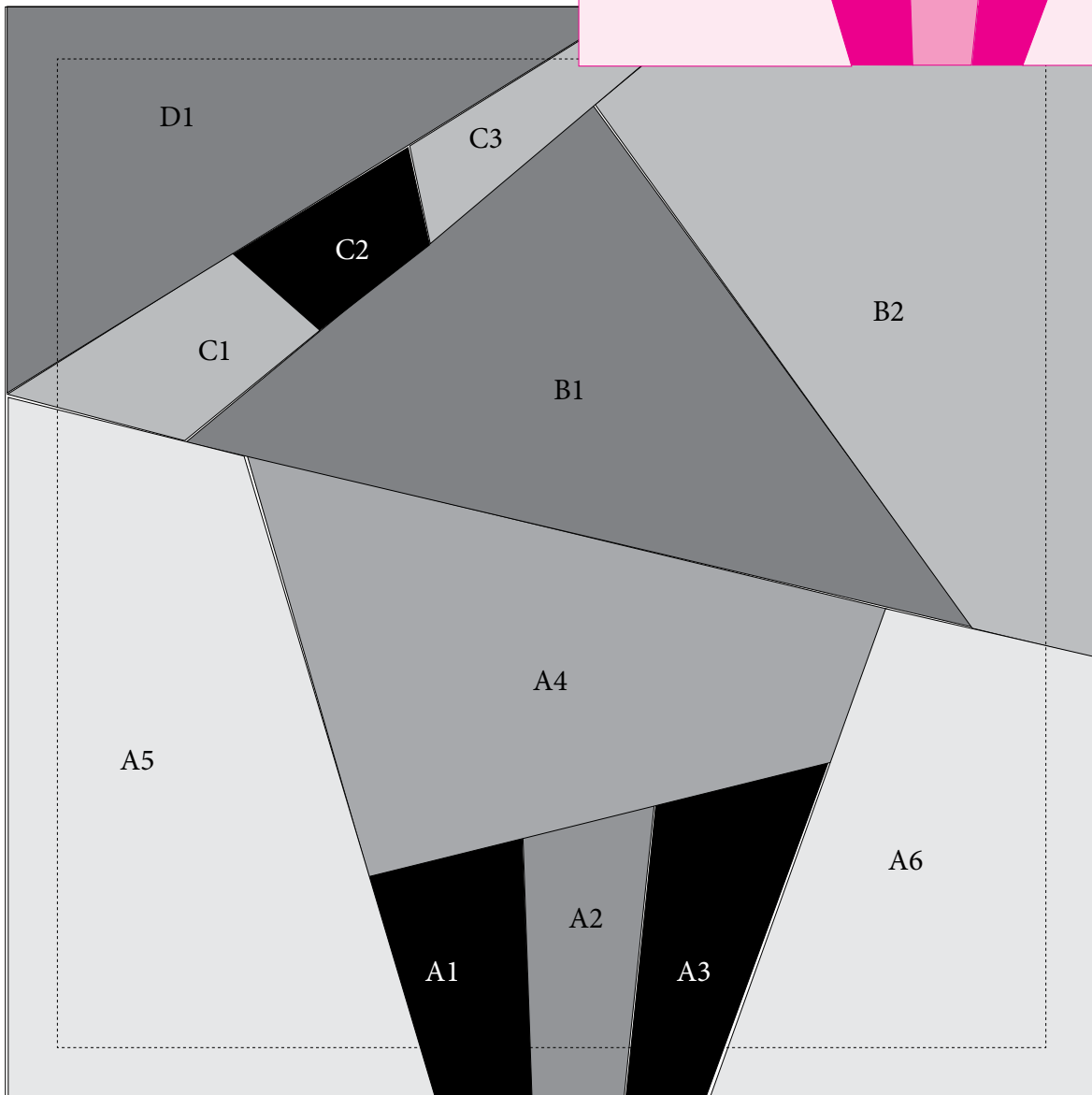
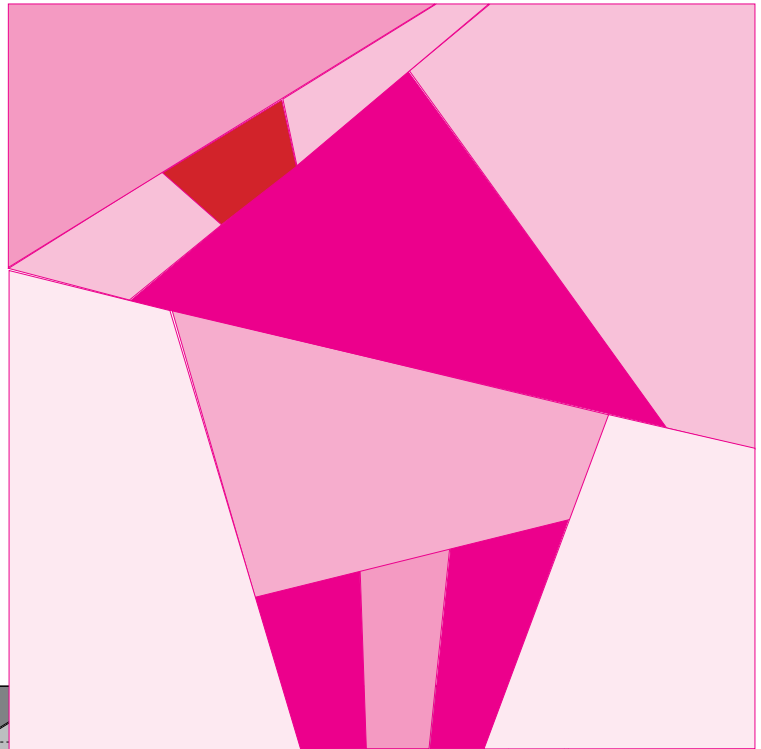
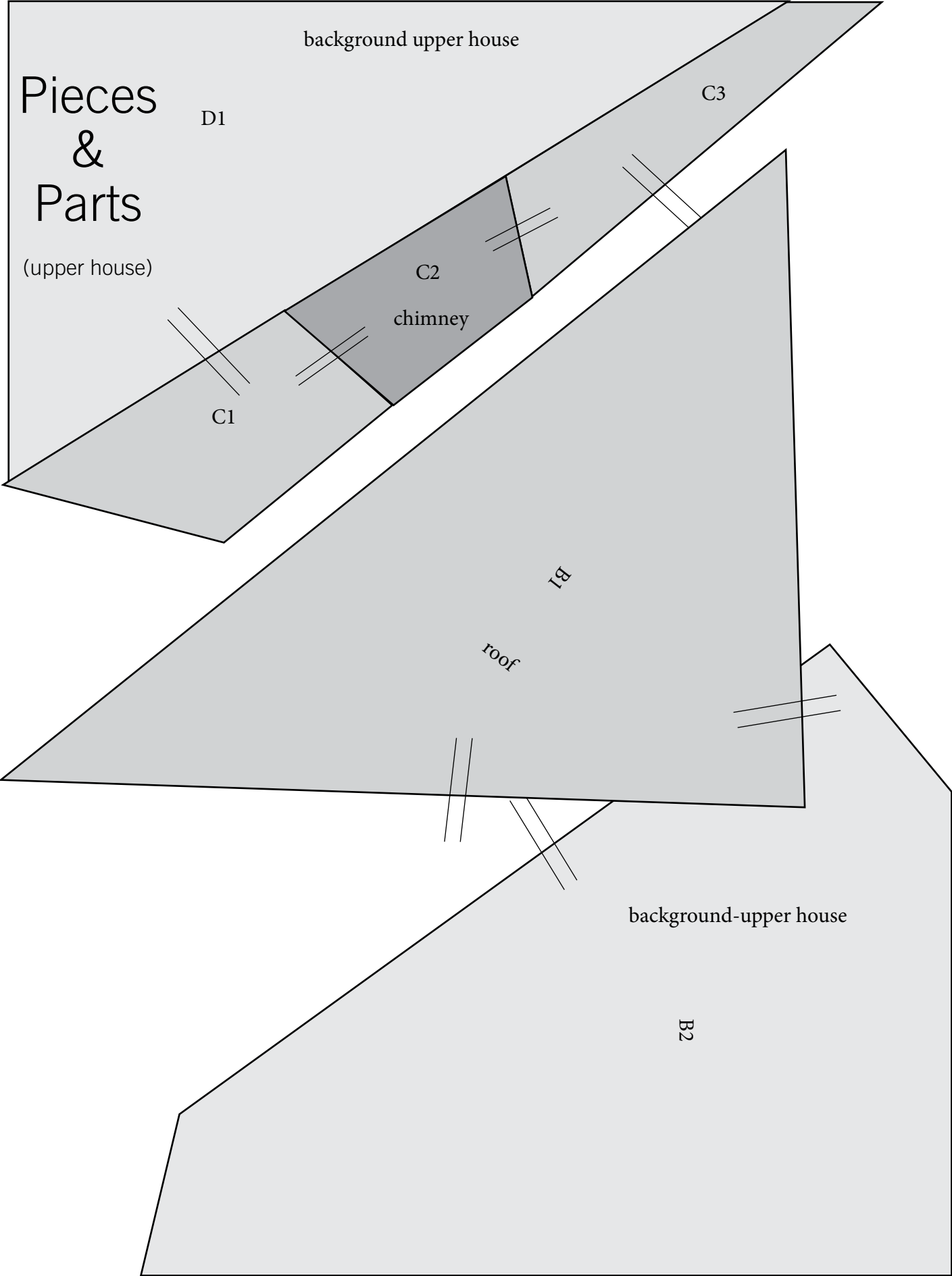

(lower house)

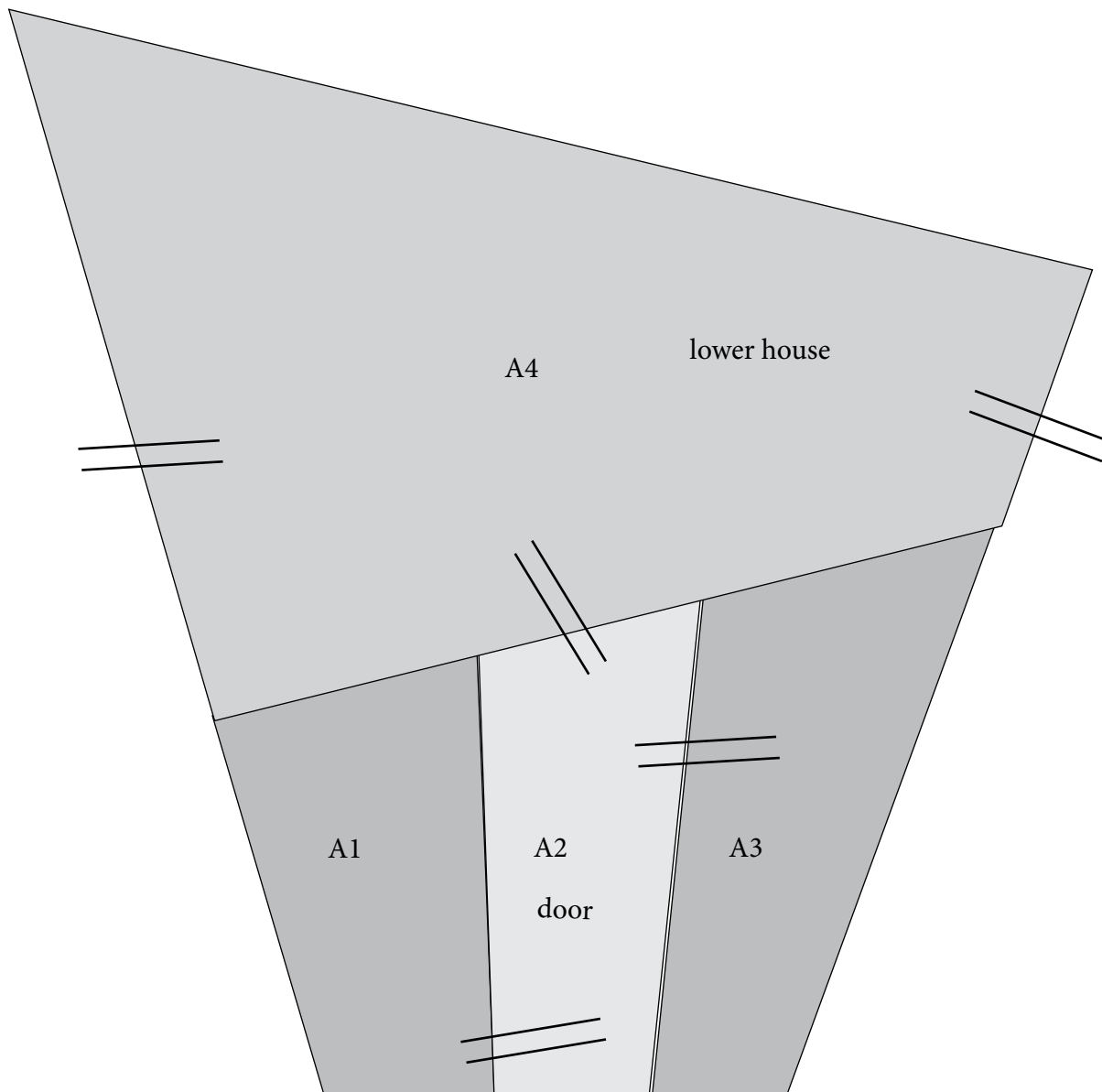
Materials for pieced house block

- scraps of pinks & reds for house blocks
- freezer paper

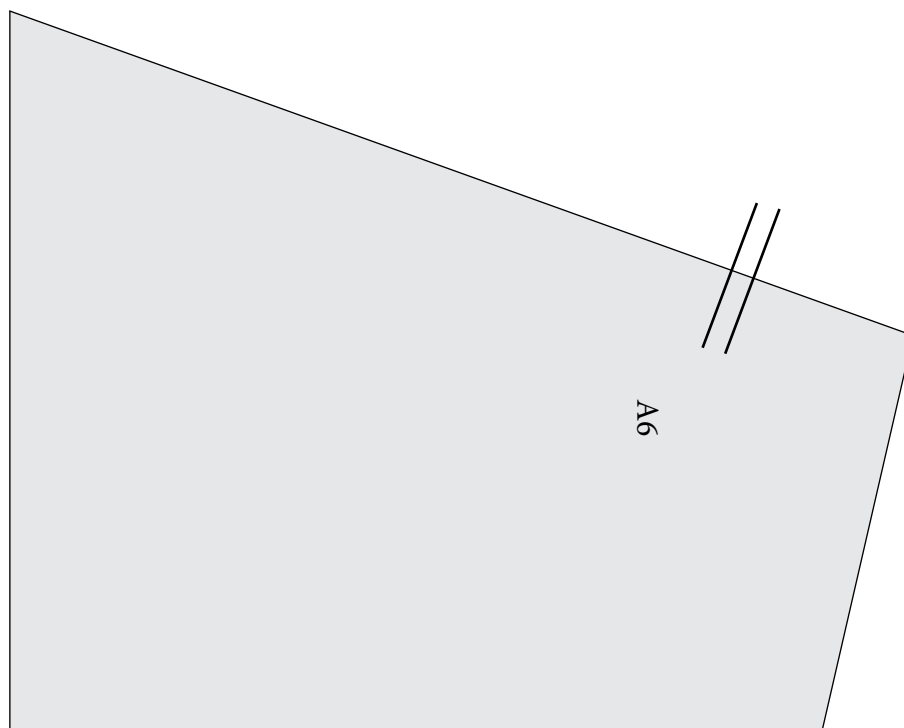
Directions

- using freezer paper, trace house shapes on to paper, be sure to include matching lines and numbers.
- iron freezer paper shapes to fabric
- add 1/4" seam allowance to all edges/sides of freezer paper
- stitching instructions (lower house)
 - stitch A1 to A2, A2 to A3
 - stitch this unit to A4
 - stitch A5 & A6 to sides

- next stitch B1 to B2 (roof and background)
- now stitch C1 to C2, C2 to C3 (chimney)
- then stitch D1 to the C units (background to chimney)
- now stitch C & D unit to B unit (chimney to roof)
- finally stitch roof/chimney to lower house
- square up to 10.5x10.5
- Voilà ~ a funky house
- embellish as desired
