

Valerie Goodwin Workshop Supply List

1. Bring hard copy map(s) of a place that has meaning to you. If you have digital images, bring those as well. Please bring maps of the same place at a variety of different scales. For instance if you want to do a map of your home, provide:

- A. Your neighborhood.
- B. Your Street
- C. Your Home

2. In addition if you can, bring jpeg pictures of the place. For instance if it is of your home bring images of the front of your home, a special tree or a nearby pond. If you have digital images, bring those as well.

3. Take your file (or hard copy) to a copy shop such as Target Copy or Kinko's. They should be able to make black and white copies inexpensively on bond paper. You may want to get a few copies just in case. Your map should be about 18" x 24".

4. About 2 weeks before the class I would like each student to email jpegs of their maps so I can give them feedback. I would like to help each person select something that can be a good starting point for their fiber art map. My email addy is: valeriegoodwin@comcast.net

5. Workshop Materials:

- Inexpensive Flat artist Brushes: ranging in size from 1/2" to 1" flat art brush
- Inexpensive 2" (+/-) house painter's brush
- A Few Foam Stencil Brushes
- Inexpensive Sponge
- Esterita Austin's Misty-White
- Teflon Sheet
- Fabric Paints (Primary colors + Black +white paint or ... a set of muted colors that you like)
- Medium sized Rotary Cutter
- Small sharp fabric scissors
- Exacto Knife + blades

- Black, white and gray thread for machine sewing (in addition bring any other thread colors that you favor from your stash)
- Gridded rotary cutter ruler
- Painter's tape
- Pins
- Needles for hand sewing
- Plastic cups or plates for mixing.
- Inexpensive Rubber Gloves
- Garbage bag
- Sewing Machine with free motion
- Any decorative threads that you like for hand sewing.
- Thimble
- Varied hand dyed solid fabrics (light, medium and dark muted values)(please bring plenty of light colors)
- 1/2 yard of Off-White or White Silk Organza (*can be purchased from <http://www.dharmatrading.com/>*)
- 1/2 yard of 100% cotton White Fabric
- 1/2 yard of 100% cotton Black Fabric
- Kimono Scraps (*optional – can be purchased from <http://www.kimkatz.com/>*)(*use these A LOT!*)
- Saral wax free transfer paper sampler pack
(5- 8-1/2" 11" sheets white, graphite, yellow, red, & blue)
- Black Micron Pens (or equivalent), Minimum 3 Point Sizes — 01 (0.25 mm), 03 (0.35 mm), and 05 (0.45 mm)
- Black Sharpie
